Guidance for Staff

- Checks must be carried out **at intervals required by licence conditions** or at least **hourly during regulated entertainment**.
 - External areas, smoking areas, beer gardens, and the site boundary must be inspected for:
 - Excessive noise
 - Loud music breakout
 - Anti-social behaviour (shouting, disturbances)
 - Engine noise, taxis, or congregating patrons
 - Any nuisance identified **must be acted on immediately** and recorded.
 - Examples of follow-up actions:
 - Reducing music volume
 - Closing windows/doors
 - Speaking with patrons
 - Asking taxis to switch off engines
 - Contacting door staff
 - Records must be **kept for a minimum of 12 months** and made available to **authorised officers** (Licensing, Police, Environmental Health) upon request.
